The company said Friday it has begun offering emergency response services, in addition to its chartered flight services, to the remote areas where many New Mexico oil fields are located.

“If a piece of equipment breaks down in the middle of the night, a company shouldn’t have to wait until dawn for a solution. That’s where we come in,” said Tommy Dunn, CSI vice president of marketing, in a news release.
