"The collective heart of our company is broken. With great sadness, we offer our sincerest condolences to all who are mourning Jeff, Amanda, Kami, and Nick. We are sharing your grief, praying for your peace and healing, and believing without a doubt that none of these exceptional human beings, will be forgotten."

An investigation of the accident is underway in coordination with relevant authorities, including the National Transportation Safety Board, the Federal Aviation Administration, and local law enforcement. CSI Aviation is cooperating fully with the investigation.
