A memorial service will be held to honor and mourn the CSI Aviation EMS crewmembers who were recently and tragically lost in an air medical flight accident on August 5th. The company's King Air N534AW crashed while enroute to pick up a patient for flight transport in Chinle, Arizona. All four crewmembers onboard perished in the accident. This service will pay tribute to them, their dedication and incredible commitment to caring for others, and their ultimate sacrifice. They will be sorely grieved, and forever missed.
