(Albuquerque, NM) - Statement on Aircraft Accident Resulting in Fatalities

It is with deep sadness that we confirm the loss of an aircraft resulting in the deaths of four CSI Aviation crew members, including two pilots and two healthcare providers. On the fifth of August 2025 at approximately 12:53 pm (MST), near Chinle, AZ, a CSI Aviation King Air that was dispatched from Albuquerque, NM to provide air ambulance services to patients in Eastern Arizona, was lost.

Emergency responders arrived promptly at the scene, and recovery operations are ongoing.

There were no patients or passengers on the aircraft.

We extend our deepest condolences to the families, friends, and loved ones of those affected by this devastating event. Support services will be made available to families and our team.

An investigation is underway in coordination with relevant authorities, including the National Transportation Safety Board, the Federal Aviation Administration, and local law enforcement. CSI Aviation is cooperating fully with the investigation. Safety is our highest priority, throughout our 46-year history we have operated without a single reportable incident or accident
